**AIS-002 (Part 1) (Rev.2):2023 Automotive Vehicles - Approval of Devices for Indirect Vision
intended for use on L category with bodywork vehicles, M and N category -
Installation Requirements**

1. Page 4/65, clause 15.2.1.1.3

Substitute following text for the existing text in Table

Main rear-view Classes III or VII:

Second Para of footnote 1 in table shall be corrected as below.

Where a single class III or VII rear-view mirror is fitted this shall be located on the right-hand side of the vehicle.

2. Page 9/65, clause 15.2.2.4

Substitute following text for the existing text:

“15.2.2.4 The prescribed Classes II, III, IV and VII mirror or monitor on the driver’s side of the vehicle shall be so located that an angle of not more than 55° is formed between the vertical longitudinal median plane of the vehicle and the vertical plane passing through the centre of the mirror or monitor and through the centre of the straight line 65 mm long which joins the driver's two ocular points. This condition shall be met if the manufacturer certifies so for the vehicles which are already approved as per AIS-002(Part 1) (Rev. 1) and there is no change in any parameter affecting the above-mentioned requirement. For new installation requirement, verification may be carried out based on agreement between the testing agency and manufacturer/applicant.

3. Page 25/65, clause 22.4

Substitute following text for the existing text:

22.4 Extension of Approvals for engineering and administrative changes:

22.4.1 In the case of 22.1, extensions shall be granted subject to the conditions of AIS-002 (Part 1) (Rev. 2): 2023. Such extensions shall be deemed to be compliance to AIS-002 (Part 1) (Rev.1):2011.

22.4.2 In the case of 22.2, extensions shall be granted subject to conditions of AIS- 002 (Part 1) (Rev.1):2011 till the notified date of implementation of AIS-002 (Part 1) (Rev.2): 2023.
