- **2. Completion Period:** The consultant shall complete all activities outlined in the bid document, in their entirety and in full compliance with all requirements, including obtaining the Fire No Objection Certificate (Fire NOC) for both Centers 1 & 2, within a period of **180 calendar days** from the date of receipt of the Purchase Order.
- 3. Period of Contract: The contract period will initially be for 180 days. The contract may be extended at the sole discretion of ICAT for a further period as per the requirement. In case the performance of the Consultant is found to be unsatisfactory asper operational parameters set out in the contract or is not in conformity with the terms & conditions of the Tender, then the contract may be terminated by ICAT even before the scheduled time by giving advance notice of 1 Week of this effect. In the event of premature contract termination for the reasons mentioned above, this EMD/Security Deposit/Performance Bank Guarantee shall be absolutely forfeited.
- 4. **Sub-Contracting:** The Consultant shall not directly or indirectly assign, sub-contract, or sublet the whole or any part of the contract if in any manner except with the specific approval of ICAT.
- 5. **Bid Validity:** The quoted rates must be valid for a period of 180 (One Hundred Eighty) days from the date of bid submission closing date. - ➤ Notwithstanding any provisions to the contrary, payment shall be processed only upon the receipt of the Fire No Objection Certificate (Fire NOC) for each respective center (ICAT Centre 1 & 2) and shall be contingent upon the submission of duly raised invoice along with the Fire NOC for the respective center. Such payment shall be subject to the verification and approval of the completed work by the relevant authorities.

8. Liquidity Damages (LD Clause):

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
