- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 2. If the bidder is a Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.

 3. OEM Turn Over Criteria: The minimum average annual financial turnover of the OEM of the offered product
- during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the OEM is less than 3 year old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
- 4. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are

not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate .The buyers are advised to refer the OM No.F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023.

- 5. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 OM_No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023 for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.
- 6. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 40% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.
- 7. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order of prices from lowest to highest. Number of sellers eligible for participating in RA would be rounded off to next higher integer value if number of technically qualified bidders is odd (e.g. if 7 bids are technically qualified, then RA will be conducted amongst L-1 to L-4). In case number of technically qualified bidders are 2 or 3, RA will be between all without any elimination. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, then minimum N sellers would be taken to RA round. In case Primary products of only one OEM are left in contention for participation in RA based on lowest 50% bidders qualifying for RA, the number of sellers qualifying for RA would be increased to get at least products of one more OEM (directly participated or through its reseller) if available. 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. Scope of Supply

Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Supply Installation Testing and Commissioning of Goods

3. Warranty

Warranty period of the supplied products shall be 2 years from the date of final acceptance of goods or after completion of installation, commissioning & testing of goods (if included in the scope of supply), at consignee location. OEM Warranty certificates must be submitted by Successful Bidder at the time of delivery of Goods. The seller should guarantee the rectification of goods in case of any break down during the guarantee period. Seller should have well established Installation, Commissioning, Training, Troubleshooting and Maintenance Service group in INDIA for attending the after sales service. Details of Service Centres near consignee destinations are to be uploaded along with the bid.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

The specifications governing the design, manufacture, testing, packaging, and accessories shall be as follows:

Other Technical Conditions:

- 1. Warranty Condition: The Coolant Conditioning Unit (CCU) shall be provided with a comprehensive on-site warranty for a duration of 24 months, commencing from the date of successful installation, testing, and commissioning. During the warranty period, the supplier shall, at no additional cost to the purchaser, provide free repair or replacement of any defective parts, including the heat exchanger, resulting from manufacturing defects or material failure. The warranty shall encompass labor, transportation, and all other costs associated with the repair or replacement of defective components. Any defects identified within the warranty period must be rectified promptly to ensure the continued proper functioning of the CCU. The successful bidder shall submit a warranty declaration, on the OEM's letterhead, confirming the 24-month warranty coverage against any manufacturing defects. This warranty shall not extend to damages arising from misuse, improper handling, or unauthorized modifications.
- 2. Project Completion Period (Inclusive of Delivery, Installation, Testing and Commissioning Activity): The successful bidder shall ensure that the delivery of the Coolant Conditioning Unit (CCU), along with all necessary testing, installation, and commissioning, is completed in full within 120 days from the date of receipt of the Purchase Order (PO) or Notice to Proceed (NTP), whichever is applicable. The supplier shall also provide all required warranty documents at the time of delivery. The entire process, including the provision of warranty documentation, must be completed within the specified timeframe. Any delays beyond the stipulated period will be subject to penalties as per the terms outlined in the tender.
- 3. Bidders are required to submit their quotations strictly in accordance with the specifications outlined in the tender. Complete technical details, including the brand, specifications, and relevant technical literature that clearly highlight the specifications of



the Coolant Conditioning Unit (CCU), must be provided along with the technical bid. A Statement of Compliance, formatted in alignment with the Technical Specifications, must be submitted for each item offered. These compliance statements must be supported by authentic and verifiable documentation. Additionally, each page of the bid, including any amendments or corrections, must be duly signed and stamped by the authorized signatory of the bidder. Failure to comply with these requirements may lead to the rejection of the bid.

- 4. **Product Availability and Support Condition:** The product offered must not be classified as "end-of-life" or "end-of-sale" as of the bid submission date. In the event that support for the quoted product is discontinued or withdrawn prior to delivery, the bidder shall, at no additional cost to the purchaser, replace the quoted product with a superior alternative that meets or exceeds the original specifications. The replacement product must be of equivalent or higher quality and functionality, ensuring no disruption to the purchaser's requirements.
- 5. Insurance of Equipment and Accessories: All materials, including the Coolant Conditioning Unit (CCU) and associated accessories, must be securely packed to prevent any damage during transit and shall be insured for the full value up to the delivery destination. The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the shipping and insurance of the equipment to ICAT, Manesar. The delivery of the materials shall be made directly to ICAT, Manesar, and the bidder shall be solely responsible for ensuring the safe and timely delivery of the goods. ICAT reserves the right to reject any components or equipment that do not meet the specified requirements during installation, testing, or inspection. In the event that any equipment or part thereof is lost or damaged during transit, the bidder shall, at no additional cost to the purchaser, provide an immediate replacement to ensure the continuity of the project.
- 6. **Sub-Contracting Not Allowed:** Sub-contracting for the Supply, Installation, Testing, and Commissioning (SITC) of the Coolant Conditioning Unit (CCU) is strictly prohibited under this tender. The bidder shall execute all work associated with SITC directly and shall not engage any third party or subcontractor to perform any part of the contract. The successful bidder will be solely responsible for full performance and compliance with all terms, conditions, and specifications outlined in the tender. Any attempt to sub-contract any aspect of SITC may result in the rejection of the bid or cancellation of the contract.

- 2. **Site Visit:** Bidders are encouraged to visit the ICAT site to inspect the location where the Coolant Conditioning Unit (CCU) is to be installed. The site visit will provide the bidders with an opportunity to assess the installation environment and ensure that the proposed solution is suitable for the specified location. The bidder should coordinate with the designated representative at ICAT to schedule the site visit.
- 3. Project Completion Period (Inclusive of Delivery, Installation, Testing and Commissioning Activity): The successful bidder shall ensure that the delivery of the Coolant Conditioning Unit (CCU), along with all necessary testing, installation, and commissioning, is completed in full within 120 days from the date of receipt of the Purchase Order (PO) or Notice to Proceed (NTP), whichever is applicable.
