- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be exempted from the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking exemption from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption.
- 2. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise (MSE) as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be exempted from the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder itself is MSE OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. - 3. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking exemption from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption.
- 4. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is DPIIT Registered OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. - 5. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM of the product offered in the bid {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the OEM is less than 3 year old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
- 7. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. - 9. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 30% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

- 10. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:

The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be (Increased quantity \div Original quantity) \times Original delivery period (in days), subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

2. Scope of Supply

3. Warranty

Warranty period of the supplied products shall be 2 years from the date of final acceptance of goods or after completion of installation, commissioning & testing of goods (if included in the scope of supply), at consignee location. OEM Warranty certificates must be submitted by Successful Bidder at the time of delivery of Goods. The seller should guarantee the rectification of goods in case of any break down during the guarantee period. Seller should have well established Installation, Commissioning, Training, Troubleshooting and Maintenance Service group in INDIA for attending the after sales service. A.4 Other Technical Conditions:

- 1. **Submission of Quotation and Technical Documentation:** The bidder shall submit a complete quotation strictly in accordance with the technical specifications detailed in the tender document. The bid must be accompanied by full technical documentation, including:
 - Brand name and model of the product,
 - > Detailed specifications,
 - > Original technical literature and product brochures clearly highlighting compliance with the tendered specifications.

Additionally, a Statement of Compliance, prepared in the format prescribed under the Technical Specification section, shall be submitted for each line item. This Statement must be supported by verifiable and authentic documentation. All pages of the bid submission, including any amendments or corrections, must be duly signed and stamped by the authorized signatory of the bidding entity. Non-compliance with these requirements may lead to outright rejection of the bid at the discretion of the purchaser.



- 2. **Product Availability and Support:** The products quoted must not be categorized as End-of-Life (EOL) or End-of-Sale (EOS) as on the date of bid submission. - > Recovery of damages, losses, or additional costs incurred as a result of such breach;

The decision of the Procuring Entity in this regard shall be **final and binding**.

In support of above, the bidder is required to submit the following documents with the technical bid:

- **Proprietary Firm**: A copy of the registration certificate or any relevant document that proves the establishment and legal validity of the proprietary firm.
- ➤ **Partnership Firm**: A copy of the Partnership Deed along with the registration certificate issued by the Registrar of Firms, if applicable.
- ➤ **Private Limited Company**: A copy of the Certificate of Incorporation issued by the Registrar of Companies (RoC) along with the Memorandum of Association (MOA) and Articles of Association (AOA).
- Agency: A copy of the registration certificate or any official document proving the legal validity and registration of the agency under the applicable law (e.g., registration under the Shops and Establishments Act, or other relevant legislation).

These documents should be enclosed along with the technical bid to demonstrate the legal status of the bidder as a valid entity.

2. **Technical Compliance Requirement:** All bidders shall be required to submit a duly filled, signed, and stamped **Technical Compliance Statement** in the format prescribed within the tender documentation. This statement must explicitly indicate compliance with each of the



technical specifications outlined in the bid document. Failure to submit the Technical Compliance Statement in the required format shall render the bid non-responsive and liable for rejection.

The bidder shall submit verifiable supporting documents, such as purchase orders, work completion certificates, or client references, clearly indicating the technical scope, quantity supplied, date of supply, and the name of the client. Bidders unable to demonstrate compliance



with the above experience criteria shall be deemed **non-responsive**, and their bids shall be rejected without further consideration.

- 8. Sample Submission and Compliance Requirement: In accordance with the requirements specified in *Annexure "A"*, all Bidders shall be mandatorily required to submit a representative sample of the quoted DC Triaxial Accelerometer within Ten (10) Calendar Days from the date of issuance of the official notification by the ICAT Technical Evaluation Committee, or within such extended period as may be formally approved in writing by ICAT. - **Conditional or Deviated Bids:** Any bid containing deviations, conditions, or modifications to the tender terms and conditions shall be summarily rejected.
- ➤ Incomplete Bid Submission: It is a mandatory requirement that bidders submit comprehensive proposals covering all items listed in the tender. Any incomplete bid, including failure to quote for any item or component, shall be treated as non-compliant. Such bids shall be rejected without further correspondence, and the bidder shall be disqualified from the evaluation process.
- > Non-Compliance with Pre-Qualification/Minimum Eligibility Criteria: Failure to satisfy any single condition under the "Pre-qualification/Minimum Eligibility Criteria" section shall result in the immediate disqualification of the bid from the tender process.
- ➤ IP Address Duplication on GeM Portal: The Government e-Marketplace (GeM) portal tracks and displays the IP addresses used by Buyers and Bidders/Sellers. Annexure - D General Terms & Conditions

- 1. Scope of Supply/Work: Supply of 15 Units of 100g DC Triaxial Accelerometers (*As per technical specification and scope of work defined in "Annexure A"*) in FTL Department at ICAT Centre 1, Manesar (Haryana).
- 2. **Submission of Quotation and Technical Documentation:** The bidder shall submit a complete quotation strictly in accordance with the technical specifications detailed in the tender document. The bid must be accompanied by full technical documentation, including:
 - Brand name and model of the product,
 - > Detailed specifications,
 - > Original technical literature and product brochures clearly highlighting compliance with the tendered specifications.

Additionally, a Statement of Compliance, prepared in the format prescribed under the Technical Specification section, shall be submitted for each line item. This Statement must be supported by verifiable and authentic documentation. All pages of the bid submission, including any amendments or corrections, must be duly signed and stamped by the authorized signatory of the bidding entity. Non-compliance with these requirements may lead to outright rejection of the bid at the discretion of the purchaser.

- 3. **Product Availability and Support:** The products quoted must not be categorized as End-of-Life (EOL) or End-of-Sale (EOS) as on the date of bid submission. The bidder shall submit a self-declaration confirming the availability and continued support of the quoted products. In the event the quoted model is withdrawn, discontinued, or becomes unsupported prior to delivery, the bidder shall, at no additional cost to ICAT, supply a functionally equivalent or superior product meeting or exceeding the original specifications. The replacement product must be of equal or better quality and functionality, ensuring no disruption to ICAT's operational requirements.
- 4. **Submission and Evaluation of Product Sample:** As part of the technical evaluation process, all bidders shall be mandatorily required to submit one (1) unit of the quoted DC Tri-axial Accelerometer as a sample, demonstrating compliance with the specifications outlined in the tender document.



- Sample Submission Timeline: The Bidder shall submit the requisite sample(s) to ICAT within Ten (10) Calendar Days from the date of issuance of a written notification by the ICAT Technical Evaluation Committee. The date of such notification shall be deemed to be the date on which the communication is dispatched by ICAT to the Bidder, either via email or through the Government e-Marketplace (GeM) portal. In the event of a delay in sample submission attributable solely to courier or logistics issues, ICAT may, at its sole discretion, grant an extension of up to Five (5) Additional Calendar Days. Such extension shall be considered only upon receipt of satisfactory documentary evidence from the Bidder, including the courier receipt and a formal written intimation of the delay.
- ➤ Evaluation Criteria: The submitted sample shall be subject to a detailed evaluation by ICAT's Technical Evaluation Committee, which will assess the product based on its build quality, functional performance, and conformity to the tender specifications. The evaluation may include testing, inspection, or trial runs, at the sole discretion of ICAT.
- Right to Accept or Reject: ICAT reserves the absolute and unconditional right to accept or reject any sample, based on the outcome of the technical evaluation. The decision of the Technical Evaluation Committee shall be final and binding on all bidders. No further correspondence or representation shall be entertained in this regard.
- Communication of Evaluation Outcome: Post completion of the evaluation, ICAT shall communicate the performance and quality assessment results to the respective bidders prior to issuing any formal acceptance or rejection. However, such communication shall be purely informative and shall not be construed as an obligation to entertain further clarifications or disputes.
- Disqualification for Non-Compliance: Bidders whose submitted samples are determined, upon evaluation by ICAT, to be non-compliant with the required quality standards or performance specifications shall be disqualified from further participation in the tender process. Furthermore, any Bidder who fails to submit the requisite sample within the stipulated period of Ten (10) Calendar Days from the date of notification, or within any formally approved extended period, shall be deemed to have failed to comply with the tender conditions and shall be disqualified forthwith. No claims, representations, or requests for reconsideration, extension, or exemption shall be entertained under any circumstances.
- 5. Delivery Period: The successful bidder shall ensure delivery of 15 Units of DC Tri-axial Accelerometers, along with all associated accessories and the original warranty documents, within 120 (one hundred twenty) calendar days from the date of receipt of the GeM Purchase Order. Timely delivery and proper commissioning are essential conditions of this contract.
- 6. **Insurance and Delivery Responsibility:** All equipment and associated materials must be securely packed and insured by the supplier up to the final delivery destination at ICAT, Manesar. The bidder shall bear full responsibility for transportation, transit insurance, handling,



and safe delivery of the equipment. ICAT reserves the right to inspect all delivered goods upon receipt. Any items found to be non-compliant with the tender specifications or damaged during transit shall be rejected. The supplier shall be obliged to replace such items at no additional cost to ICAT, without affecting the overall delivery schedule.

- 7. **Warranty Conditions:** The supplied DC Tri-axial Accelerometers shall carry a comprehensive on-site warranty for a period of **Twenty (24) Months** from the date of successful delivery and acceptance by ICAT. During the warranty period:

- 11. **Liquidity Damages (LD Clause):** The material should be delivered strictly as per the time limits specified in the GeM purchase order, if L1 bidder fail to complete the delivery within the stipulated time will make L1 bidder will be liable to pay an unconditional penalty of ½% (Half Percent) total order value per week delay subjected to a maximum of 10% (Ten Percent) of the total order value.
- 12. **Payment Terms:** Subject to compliance with all contractual obligations, 100% of the contract value shall be payable to the successful bidder within fifteen (15) days from the date of final acceptance of all 15 Units of DC Tri-Axial Accelerometers by ICAT, provided that the bidder has submitted a valid Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) equivalent to five percent (5%) of the total contract value. In the event the bidder fails to furnish the required Performance Bank Guarantee within the stipulated timeframe, ICAT shall be entitled to withhold an amount equivalent to 5% of the final invoice value, which shall be retained as a Retention Amount. This amount shall be held by ICAT until the successful completion of the warranty period of **Twenty (24) Months**, and shall be released thereafter, subject to the supplier's full compliance with all warranty obligations and other contractual terms. All payments shall be made after deduction of applicable taxes, levies, and statutory charges in accordance with the prevailing laws and regulations.



No payment shall be processed prior to either: (a) the submission and acceptance of the Performance Bank Guarantee, or (b) the retention of an equivalent amount by ICAT in lieu of the PBG, as applicable.

- 13. **Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG):** The successful bidder shall furnish a Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) amounting to 5% of the total contract value within fifteen (15) calendar days from the date of issuance of the Notification of Award (NoA)/GeM Contract. The PBG must be issued by a scheduled commercial bank located in India, in the format prescribed by the Purchaser. It shall clearly state the full address of the issuing bank, along with the name, designation, telephone number, email ID, and fax number of the bank's authorized signatory.
 - ➤ Validity Period: The PBG shall remain valid for a minimum period of Twenty (24) Months from the date of final acceptance of the refurbished system, or such longer period as may be required to cover the full duration of the warranty/guarantee period, as specified in the contract.
 - ➤ Retention in Lieu of Non-Submission of Performance Bank Guarantee: Should the successful bidder fail to furnish the required Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) within the prescribed timeframe, ICAT reserves the right to withhold an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total contract value from the bidder's final invoice. Such withheld amount shall be retained by ICAT as a security in lieu of the PBG, without any accrual of interest. The retention amount shall be released to the bidder solely upon the successful completion of the warranty period and upon the full and satisfactory fulfilment of all contractual obligations, including the resolution of any outstanding issues.
 - ➤ Non-Submission of PBG: In the event the selected bidder fails to submit the Performance Bank Guarantee within the stipulated period, ICAT reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to either cancel the award and forfeit the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) or, alternatively, deduct an amount equivalent to 5% of the total contract value from the final invoice as a retention amount. This amount shall be held by ICAT until the successful completion of the warranty/guarantee period and fulfilment of all contractual obligations.
 - > **Invocation of PBG:** ICAT shall have the absolute right to invoke the Performance Bank Guarantee at any time during its validity, either in part or in full, if the contractor fails to perform its obligations under the contract, causes undue delay, or if any loss, damage, or expense is incurred by ICAT due to breach, default, or negligence by the contractor.



- ➤ **Refund of PBG or Retained Amount:** Subject to satisfactory completion of all contractual obligations and the warranty/guarantee period, the PBG or the retention amount (as applicable) shall be released within thirty (30) days from the date of final closure of all liabilities, based on written recommendation from the concerned technical authority of ICAT.
- ➤ **No Interest Payable:** No interest or financial charges shall be payable by ICAT on the PBG amount or on any amount retained in lieu thereof.
- ➤ Retention in Lieu of Non-Submission of Performance Bank Guarantee: Should the successful bidder fail to furnish the required Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) within the prescribed timeframe, ICAT reserves the right to withhold an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total contract value from the bidder's final invoice. Such withheld amount shall be retained by ICAT as a security in lieu of the PBG, without any accrual of interest. The retention amount shall be released to the bidder solely upon the successful completion of the warranty period and upon the full and satisfactory fulfilment of all contractual obligations, including the resolution of any outstanding issues.
- 14. **Delivery Terms:** The delivery of all materials, equipment, components, and tools required for the execution of the contract shall be on a Free on Road (FOR) basis to the ICAT Project Site at Manesar. The responsibility for packing, forwarding, loading, transportation, transit insurance, and unloading of all goods at the designated ICAT site shall rest solely with the Contractor. All deliveries shall be made in good condition, properly secured, and ready for immediate use or installation, as applicable under the contract.
- 15. **Sub-Contracting Clause:** Restriction on Sub-Contracting Without Prior Approval The Contractor shall not, without the prior written consent of the Procuring Entity, assign, sublet, transfer, or otherwise dispose of the contract or any part thereof, or any interest, benefit, claim, or advantage arising therefrom, in any form or manner whatsoever. Any such action undertaken without prior written approval shall be deemed unauthorized and invalid.

If the Contractor proposes to engage sub-contractors for any portion of the contract not previously disclosed in the original bid or contract agreement, the Contractor shall provide **prior written notification** to the Procuring Entity. Sub-contracting, where permitted, shall be **limited strictly to ancillary or incidental services**, including the supply of bought-out items or components. Under no circumstances shall sub-contracting be used to delegate core responsibilities, obligations, or deliverables that formed the basis of contract award. The Contractor shall remain fully responsible and liable for the performance of all obligations under the contract, including those carried out by any sub-contractor. No sub-contract shall relieve the Contractor of any contractual responsibilities, obligations, or liabilities, whether arising under this contract or under applicable law.

Any unauthorized assignment, subletting, or transfer of the contract, in whole or in part, shall constitute a material breach of contract, entitling the Procuring Entity to exercise any and all contractual remedies available to it, including but not limited to:



- ➤ Termination of the contract, in whole or in part;
- Forfeiture of performance guarantees or security deposits;
- Recovery of damages, losses, or additional costs incurred as a result of such breach;
- Legal action under applicable laws or regulations.

The decision of the Procuring Entity in this regard shall be **final and binding**.

- 16. **Offer Validity:** Offers should be valid for a minimum of **One Hundred Eighty (180) Days** from the date of opening the Technical Bid. A bid, valid for a shorter period, is liable to be rejected. ICAT and Manesar may ask the bidders to extend the period of validity, if required.
- 17. **Right to Amend Terms:** The Purchaser, i.e., ICAT, reserves the right to modify, amend, or supplement any of the terms, conditions, specifications, or eligibility criteria set forth in this tender document, at any stage, in order to align with evolving project priorities, technical requirements, or administrative needs. Such modifications, if any, shall be communicated to all participating bidders through written addenda or corrigenda issued by ICAT.
- 18. **Price Quotation and Correction:** All prices must be quoted in Indian Rupees (INR) and shall be entered in numerical figures only. In the event of any arithmetic discrepancy between the unit price and the total price derived from the multiplication of unit price by quantity, the unit price shall be deemed correct, and the total price shall be corrected accordingly. If the bidder does not accept the correction of errors, the bid shall be rejected.
- 19. **Acceptance of Terms:** The bidder is required to sign and stamp all pages of the tender document, including any corrigenda or annexures, as a token of unconditional acceptance of all terms, conditions, and obligations stated therein. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in rejection of the bid on procedural grounds.
- 20. **Rejection of Conditional Bids:** Bidders are required to submit their offers strictly in accordance with the terms, conditions, and specifications stipulated in this tender document. Conditional bids or bids containing deviations, assumptions, qualifications, or conditions not expressly permitted in the tender shall be considered non-responsive and are liable to be summarily rejected without any further notice or obligation on the part of the Purchaser. The Purchaser shall not entertain any correspondence or clarification on such rejected bids, and the decision of the Purchaser in this regard shall be final, binding, and non-contestable.



- 21. **Qualification Criteria:** Only those bids that meet the technical specifications and evaluation criteria as outlined in the tender document shall be considered. Bidders must provide all necessary documentation to demonstrate compliance with these criteria.
- 22. **Award of Contract:** The contract shall be awarded to the bidder who satisfies the qualification criteria and offers the lowest (L1) price, subject to compliance with all other terms and conditions of the tender.
- 23. **Governing Law:** This tender and any resulting contract shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Republic of India.

24. Submission of Modifications or Improvements to Conditions of Contract

- Permissibility of Proposals: Bidders are permitted to submit proposals for modifications or improvements to the Conditions of Contract, provided that such proposals are justified, clearly articulated, and demonstrably serve the best interests of the International Centre for Automotive Technology (ICAT). All such proposals must relate directly to the scope and objectives of the present tender and shall be expressed in clear, concise, and unambiguous terms.
- ➤ Form and Manner of Submission: All proposed modifications or improvements shall be submitted using the prescribed format titled "Deviations or Modifications Suggested Form X(B)" and shall be uploaded through the Government e-Marketplace (GeM) portal or submitted via the designated email address(es) as specified in the bid documents. Such submissions must be made no later than seventy-two (72) hours prior to the official bid submission deadline. Any submissions received beyond this period shall be summarily disregarded and shall not be considered for evaluation.
- ▶ **Declaration of No Deviation:** In the event that a bidder does not intend to propose any modifications or improvements to the Conditions of Contract, the bidder shall make an express declaration to this effect by stating "No Deviation Suggested" in Form X(B). Failure to submit either the completed Form X(B) or the express declaration within the prescribed period shall be construed as the bidder's unconditional acceptance of all terms and conditions set forth in the tender document.
- ➤ **Finality of Submissions:** No deviations, modifications, or conditional proposals shall be entertained after the expiry of the deadline or at any stage post bid submission. Bids containing late, conditional, or non-compliant submissions shall be liable for outright rejection without any further correspondence, clarification, or recourse to the bidder.
- > ICAT's Discretion: ICAT reserves the sole, absolute, and unfettered right to accept or reject, in whole or in part, any modifications or improvements proposed by any bidder. Acceptance of any such proposals shall be communicated through the issuance of a corrigendum to the tender document. ICAT may, at its discretion, revise the bid submission deadline to provide



all prospective bidders adequate time to consider the corrigendum and submit revised bids, if necessary.

- 25. **Right to Modify or Withdraw Tender:** The issuance of this tender document does not constitute an offer and is issued with no commitment. ICAT reserves the right to withdraw this notice inviting tender or modify any part thereof at any stage. ICAT further reserves the right to disqualify any bidder, should it be necessary at any stage. ICAT reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders, wholly or partly, without assigning any reason thereof and shall not be bound to accept the lowest tender.
- 26. **Confidentiality:** Both ICAT and the Selected Bidder shall maintain the confidentiality of all proprietary information exchanged during the course of this contract. Neither party shall disclose any confidential information to third parties without the prior written consent of the other, except as required by law. This obligation shall survive the termination or completion of the contract.
- 27. **Unsatisfactory Performance:** The Bidder acknowledges and agrees that ICAT shall have the sole discretion to assess the performance of any component(s) supplied under this contract, whether primary or final. Should ICAT determine, at its sole discretion, that any such component(s) are unsatisfactory or fail to meet the specified requirements, ICAT reserves the right to reject the component(s) in whole or in part, without incurring any liability, whether direct or indirect, to the Bidder. This right may be exercised during the pre-commissioning or post-commissioning phases, as applicable. The Bidder agrees to be bound by ICAT's decision and shall take all necessary actions to rectify any deficiencies promptly.
- 28. **Termination of Contract:** In the event of unsatisfactory performance by the Vendor, ICAT shall issue a written warning letter detailing the deficiencies observed. If, after a period of fourteen (14) calendar days from the date of the first warning letter, the Vendor fails to address the issues to ICAT's satisfaction, a second warning letter shall be issued. Should the Vendor's performance remain unsatisfactory after the second warning letter, ICAT reserves the right to terminate the contract by providing one (1) month's written notice to the Vendor, without assigning any further reason. Upon termination, any amounts deemed payable to the Vendor shall be forfeited, and no further claims shall be entertained. The Vendor shall remove all equipment, materials, and personnel from ICAT's premises within thirty (30) calendar days of contract termination. ICAT's decision regarding the determination of performance shall be final and binding.



- 29. **Dispute Resolution:** Any dispute or difference arising out of or in connection with this tender shall first be attempted to be resolved through amicable negotiations between the parties. If the dispute remains unresolved within thirty (30) calendar days, it shall be referred to arbitration. Arbitration shall be conducted in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, by an arbitrator appointed by the Director of ICAT. The venue of arbitration shall be in Gurugram, Haryana, and the language of arbitration shall be English. The decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both parties. In the event that the dispute is not resolved through arbitration, the matter shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts in Gurugram, Haryana.
- 30. **Fraud and Corruption:** The bidders, suppliers and contractors shall observe the highest standard of ethics during bidding and during performance of the contract. For the purposes of this provision, the following acts shall be considered as corrupt and/or fraudulent practices.
 - ➤ "Corrupt Practice" means offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting directly or indirectly, of anything of value to influence the action of an official in the procurement process or in contract execution.
 - "Fraudulent Practice" means misrepresentation or omission of facts in order to execution of contract.
 - "Collusive Practice" means a scheme or arrangement between two or more bidders, with or without the knowledge of the purchaser, designed to establish bid prices at artificial, noncompetitive level.
 - "Coercive Practice" means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in a procurement process or in execution of a contract.
 - > During the process of evaluation of a bid or proposal for award of a contract, if it is detected that a bidder directly or through agent has engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive or coercive practice in competing for the contract in question, then a) the bid shall be rejected and b) declare the firm ineligible for a specific period or indefinitely to participate in a bidding process.
 - ➤ Bidders may note that GeM is capturing and showing the IP addresses used by the Buyer and Bidder(s)/Seller(s). Bids submitted from IP addresses that are identical to or shared with other Bidders/Sellers shall be deemed invalid and automatically disqualified from further evaluation.
- 31. **Collusive Bidding or Bid Rigging or Cartelization:** The Bidder(s) acknowledges and agrees that any form of bid rigging, cartelization, or coordination among bidders, aimed at manipulating the bidding process or prices, is strictly prohibited. In the event of any evidence or suspicion of collusion, bid rigging, or cartel behavior, the Tendering Authority reserves the right to reject the



bid(s) and take appropriate legal action, including but not limited to debarment from future tenders and reporting to relevant authorities. Bidders are required to submit their bids independently, without any undue influence or agreement with other participants in the tender process.

- 32. MSME Exemption Applicability: If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 33. **Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):** Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document.
