- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be exempted from the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking exemption from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption.
- 2. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise (MSE) as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be exempted from the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder itself is MSE OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking exemption from Turnover, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption.
- 3. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking exemption from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption.
- 4. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is DPIIT Registered OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking exemption from Turnover shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption.
- 5. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM of the product offered in the bid {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or

similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts and delivery acceptance certificates like CRAC to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.

- 6. OEM Turn Over Criteria: The minimum average annual financial turnover of the OEM of the offered product during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the OEM is less than 3 year old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
- 7. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate .The buyers are advised to refer the OM No.F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023.
- OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023 for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017.
- 8. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023 for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.
- 9. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.
- 10. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 30% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.
- 11. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order of prices from lowest to highest. Number of sellers eligible for participating in RA would be rounded off to next higher integer value if number of technically qualified bidders is odd (e.g. if 7 bids are technically qualified, then RA will be conducted amongst L-1 to L-4). In case number of technically qualified bidders are 2 or 3, RA will be between all without any elimination. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, then minimum N

sellers would be taken to RA round. In case Primary products of only one OEM are left in contention for participation in RA based on lowest 50% bidders qualifying for RA, the number of sellers qualifying for RA would be increased to get at least products of one more OEM (directly participated or through its reseller) if available. Further, if bid(s) of any seller(s) eligible for MSE preference is / are coming within price band of 15% of Non MSE L-1 or if bid of any seller(s) eligible for Make in India preference is / are coming within price band of 20% of non MII L-1, then such MSE / Make in India seller shall also be allowed to participate in the RA process.

Buyer are also requested to verify the key no of OS etc with server of Microsoft/Linux before accepting machines to avoid complexity at latter stage.

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be (Increased quantity \div Original quantity) \times Original delivery period (in days), subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

2. Scope of Supply

Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components): Only supply of Goods

3. Warranty

Warranty period of the supplied products shall be 3 years from the date of final acceptance of goods or after completion of installation, commissioning & testing of goods (if included in the scope of supply), at consignee location. EMD should be forfeited in favour of ICAT in case the Bidder: -

- The EMD may be forfeited, if a Bidder withdraws his bid during the period of bid validity or on submission of false documents/undertaking.
- Without the written consent of ICAT, it has withdrawn its Bid during the validity period of the Bids and any extensions thereto.
- After opening of the financial bid, alters the quoted rates/conditions in the Bid.
- Fails to provide / furnish the Performance Bank Guarantee within stipulated period mentioned in the Letter of Acceptance.
- Does not reply to any queries that may be raised after opening of technical/financial bids.
- If the bidder does not accept the corrections made by ICAT to its Bid Price pursuant to "Examination of Financial Proposal and Correction of Arithmetical Errors".



Annexure C Eligibility & Technical Evaluation Criteria

Eligibility Criteria: The following mentions the pre-qualification criteria. A bidder participating in the procurement process shall possess the following pre-qualification/minimum eligibility criteria: Any bid failing to meet the stated criteria shall be summarily rejected and will not be considered for technical evaluation.

Pre-qualification/Minimum Eligibility Criteria for the Bidders:

- 1. **Legal Valid Entity:** The bidder shall necessarily be a legal valid entity in the form of a proprietary firm, partnership firm, private limited company, or agency (enclose a copy of the registration or incorporation certificate with the technical bid).
 - In support of above, the bidder is required to submit the following documents with the technical bid:
 - **Proprietary Firm**: A copy of the registration certificate or any relevant document that proves the establishment and legal validity of the proprietary firm.
 - **Partnership Firm**: A copy of the Partnership Deed along with the registration certificate issued by the Registrar of Firms, if applicable.
 - ➤ **Private Limited Company**: A copy of the Certificate of Incorporation issued by the Registrar of Companies (RoC) along with the Memorandum of Association (MOA) and Articles of Association (AOA).
 - ➤ **Agency**: A copy of the registration certificate or any official document proving the legal validity and registration of the agency under the applicable law (e.g., registration under the Shops and Establishments Act, or other relevant legislation).

These documents should be enclosed along with the technical bid to demonstrate the legal status of the bidder as a valid entity.

- 2. Bidders are required to submit the duly filled and signed technical compliance for the technical specifications.
- 3. It is a mandatory requirement for bidders to submit comprehensive proposals covering all items specified in the bid document. Any bidder who submits an incomplete proposal, including but not limited to failure to provide a bid for any item or part thereof, shall be considered non-compliant with the tender specifications. Such incomplete proposals shall be rejected and automatically disqualified from further evaluation. Bidders are required to ensure that their proposal includes valid offers for all items as detailed in the tender documents. Non-compliance with this condition shall result in the outright rejection of the bid.



- 4. Bidders should be India-based.

These clients may include Central Government Departments, State Government Departments, Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs), Autonomous Bodies and Reputed Private Organizations in India Copies of Purchase Orders/Completion Certificates/Client Testimonials must be provided as proof.
- 9. **Blacklisting Declaration:** The bidder must not be blacklisted or debarred by any Central or State Government Department, Public Sector Undertaking, Autonomous Body, or reputed



private organization in India. A duly signed Self-Declaration on the bidder's letterhead to this effect must be submitted along with the tender documents.

10. After-Sales Service Support Facility: The bidder must have an operational service support facility located within India, capable of handling breakdowns or technical issues during and beyond the warranty period. A self-declaration on the bidder's official letterhead, confirming the existence and availability of such a service support facility, must be submitted as part of the bid.

Bidders to Comply with:

- 11. - 12. Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP) vide No. P-45021/2/2017-PP (BE-II) dated 04.06.2020 and as revised from time to time regarding bidders eligibility and preference to make in India (https://dpiit.gov.in/sites/default/files/PPP%20MII%20Order%20dated%204th%20June%202 020.pdf).

Note:

- ICAT reserves the right to give preference to the local supplier, MSME, or start-up as per prevailing government notifications and as revised from time to time.
- MSE Public Procurement Policy is meant for the procurement of only goods produced and services rendered by MSEs. However, traders, distributors, sole agents, and works contracts are excluded from the purview of the Public Procurement Policy for MSEs Order, 2012.
- It is clarified that the relaxation of prior turnover and prior experience with respect to micro
 and small enterprises is subject to meeting the quality and technical specifications given in the
 bid document.



Bid Rejection Criteria:

Bids submitted in response to this tender shall be subject to rejection at any stage of evaluation under any of the following conditions:

- 1. **Non-Submission of OEM Authorization:** Failure to submit a valid Authorization Certificate from the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) in the prescribed format *(Form XIV)*, in cases where the bidder is not the OEM.

- 1. **Scope of Supply/Work:** Supply of **Toughbook's (As per specification given in "Annexure A")** at ICAT Centre 1 & 2, Manesar (Haryana).
- 2. Product Availability and OEM Support Condition: The offered Toughbook models shall not be classified as "End-of-Life" or "End-of-Sale" as on the date of bid submission. If the OEM discontinues support for the quoted product prior to delivery, the bidder shall, at no additional cost to the Purchaser, provide a replacement product of equal or higher specifications and quality that is fully compliant with the tender requirements. Such replacement shall be subject to prior written approval by the Purchaser and must not cause any delay or disruption to the project timelines.
 - Product Lifecycle Compliance: The bidder shall offer only those products which are currently active in the market and not classified as obsolete or nearing obsolescence. The product offered must have a minimum residual market life of Minimum Five (5) Years from the date of bid submission, as certified by the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM). Products declared as End-of-Life (EOL) by the OEM within this period will not be accepted.
 - ➤ Post-Installation Support and Spare Availability: The bidder shall ensure that all necessary spares and consumables for the proposed equipment will be available and supported for a minimum period of Five (5) Years following the successful installation and commissioning of the equipment. All spares and consumables must be accessible through the Government e-Marketplace (GeM) platform throughout this support period. - 4. **Liquidity Damages (LD Clause):** The material should be delivered strictly as per the time limits specified in the GeM purchase order, if L1 bidder fail to complete the delivery within the stipulated time will make L1 bidder will be liable to pay an unconditional penalty of ½% (Half



Percent) total order value per week delay subjected to a maximum of 10% (Ten Percent) of the total order value.

- Warranty Conditions: The Toughbook's being procured comprising Semi-Rugged (3 Nos.),
 Fully Rugged (2 Nos.), and Regular Rugged (5 Nos.) shall be covered under a comprehensive onsite warranty as follows

The bidder shall submit a Warranty Declaration on the OEM's letterhead, confirming the above coverage. The warranty shall exclude damages arising from misuse, mishandling, or unauthorized alterations to the equipment.

- 6. OEM Authorization Certificate: All participating bidders are required to submit a valid OEM Authorization Certificate along with their bid. The certificate must be in the format prescribed in the Buyer-uploaded Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC) document and duly signed and stamped by the OEM. Bids submitted without the prescribed authorization format shall be summarily rejected.
- 7. **After-Sales Support for Products:** It is mandatory that the OEM or its Authorized Seller has a registered office in India capable of providing comprehensive after-sales service and support. A certificate confirming the presence of such an office in India, along with the address and contact details, must be submitted as part of the bid. Failure to provide this certificate shall render the bid non-compliant.
- 8. **Insurance and Safe Delivery of Materials:** All goods shall be packed securely to prevent transit damage and shall be fully insured up to the destination at ICAT, Manesar. The bidder shall bear full responsibility for

- 9. Delivery Terms: The delivery shall be made on a FOR (Free on Road) ICAT Site basis. The scope of the bidder shall include all activities related to packing, forwarding, loading, transportation, transit insurance, and unloading at the ICAT project site as per the technical specifications.
- 10. Non-Transferability of Tender Document and Bid Rights: The tender document is non-transferable. Under no circumstances shall it be assigned, transferred, or sublet by the bidder to any third party, either in whole or in part. Further, the rights and obligations under this tender and any subsequent contract awarded pursuant to it shall solely vest with the successful bidder. No sub-letting, assignment, or transfer of the bid, work, or any portion thereof shall be permitted without the prior written consent of the Purchaser. Any unauthorized attempt by the bidder to transfer the tender or any associated rights may result in:
 - Immediate rejection of the bid
 - Termination of the contract, if already awarded
 - ➤ Forfeiture of EMD/Performance Security
 - > Debarment from future tenders
- 11. Payment Terms: 100% of the invoice value will be paid to the GeM L1 Bidder after successful delivery and final acceptance of Toughbook's along with all associated accessories. Prior to the release of payment, the bidder must submit a Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) from a nationalized or scheduled bank, equivalent to 5% of the total contract value. This PBG must remain valid for a period of 36 Months (3 Years), starting from the date of satisfactory completion of the entire scope of work, including installation, commissioning, and acceptance testing. The Performance Bank Guarantee should be unconditional, in favor of the client, and must cover any defects in material, workmanship, or performance of the Toughbook's for the duration of the warranty period i.e., 36 Months (3 Years).

12. Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG):

- ➤ Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) Requirement: The selected bidder shall be required to provide a Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) within 15 days from the date of the Notification of Award. The value of the PBG shall be equivalent to 5% of the total order value. The PBG shall include the full address of the issuing bank, along with the contact details of the person responsible, including name, contact number, fax number, and email ID.
- ➤ Validity of Performance Bank Guarantee: The Performance Bank Guarantee shall remain valid for the entire warranty period of 36 Months (3 Years), or such other duration as stipulated in the contract.
- ➤ Failure to Submit Performance Bank Guarantee: In the event the selected bidder fails to submit the Performance Bank Guarantee within the stipulated time frame, ICAT reserves the right to cancel the order placed with the selected bidder, without notice, and to forfeit the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD).
- ➤ Invocation of Performance Bank Guarantee: ICAT shall have the right to invoke the Performance Bank Guarantee if the selected bidder fails to fulfill its contractual obligations during the contract period or if ICAT incurs any loss due to the bidder's negligence in carrying out the project implementation in accordance with the agreed terms and conditions.
- ➤ **Refund of Performance Bank Guarantee:** The Performance Bank Guarantee shall be refunded within 30 days following the successful completion of the contract period, specifically upon the expiry of the warranty and support services for the equipment.
- ➤ **No Interest on Performance Bank Guarantee:** ICAT shall not be liable to pay any interest on the amount of the Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG).
- 13. **Sub-Contracting Clause:** Restriction on Sub-Contracting Without Prior Approval The Contractor shall not, without the prior written consent of the Procuring Entity, assign, sublet, transfer, or otherwise dispose of the contract or any part thereof, or any interest, benefit,



claim, or advantage arising therefrom, in any form or manner whatsoever. Any such action undertaken without prior written approval shall be deemed unauthorized and invalid.

If the Contractor proposes to engage sub-contractors for any portion of the contract not previously disclosed in the original bid or contract agreement, the Contractor shall provide **prior written notification** to the Procuring Entity. Sub-contracting, where permitted, shall be **limited strictly to ancillary or incidental services**, including the supply of bought-out items or components. Under no circumstances shall sub-contracting be used to delegate core responsibilities, obligations, or deliverables that formed the basis of contract award. The Contractor shall remain fully responsible and liable for the performance of all obligations under the contract, including those carried out by any sub-contractor. No sub-contract shall relieve the Contractor of any contractual responsibilities, obligations, or liabilities, whether arising under this contract or under applicable law.

Any unauthorized assignment, subletting, or transfer of the contract, in whole or in part, shall constitute a material breach of contract, entitling the Procuring Entity to exercise any and all contractual remedies available to it, including but not limited to:

- > Termination of the contract, in whole or in part;
- Forfeiture of performance guarantees or security deposits;
- ➤ Recovery of damages, losses, or additional costs incurred as a result of such breach;
- ➤ Legal action under applicable laws or regulations.

The decision of the Procuring Entity in this regard shall be **final and binding**.

14. Submission of Modifications or Improvements to Conditions of Contract: Bidders are permitted to propose and justify any modifications or improvements to the Conditions of Contract that, in their opinion, would serve the best interest of the International Centre for Automotive Technology (ICAT). Such proposals must be clear, concise, and directly relevant to the tender scope.

If bidder does not propose any modifications or improvements to the Conditions of Contract, the bidder shall explicitly declare this by stating "No Deviation Suggested Form – X(A)" in the prescribed "Deviations or Modifications Suggested Form – X(B)". Failure to submit this declaration may be construed as non-compliance with the tender submission requirements.

All proposed modifications or improvements must be submitted no later than seventy-two (72) hours prior to the official bid submission deadline. Any submissions received after this period shall be summarily disregarded.



ICAT reserves the exclusive and unconditional right to accept or reject, wholly or partially, any such proposed modifications or improvements at its sole discretion. If any proposals are accepted, ICAT will issue a corrigendum detailing the approved changes. Consequently, the bid submission deadline may be extended to allow all prospective bidders sufficient time to consider the issued corrigendum and revise their submissions accordingly.

Failure to submit any proposed changes within the stipulated timeframe shall be deemed unconditional acceptance of all terms and conditions stated in the original tender document.

No modifications, deviations, or conditional submissions will be accepted after the bid submission deadline. Any such conditional or non-compliant bids shall be rejected outright without further correspondence or clarification.

- 15. **Offer Validity:** Offers should be valid for a minimum of **One Hundred Eighty (180) Days** from the date of opening the Technical Bid. A bid, valid for a shorter period, is liable to be rejected. ICAT and Manesar may ask the bidders to extend the period of validity, if required.
- 16. ICAT reserves the right to modify and amend any of the conditions/criterion depending upon project priorities and needs.

Even after arbitration if any questions, disputes and/or difference arise under and out of, or in connection with the work, if concluded, shall be referred to the High Court of Haryana or any other court in the District of Gurugram (Haryana).
- 23. The tender document is not an offer and is issued with no commitment. ICAT reserves the right to withdraw this notice inviting tender or vary any part thereof at any stage. ICAT further reserves the right to disqualify any bidder, should it be so necessary at any stage. ICAT reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders, wholly or partly, without assigning any reason thereof and shall not be bound to accept the lowest tender.
- 24. Law of the Republic of India are applicable to this tender.
- 25. **Qualification Criteria:** The bidder whose bid meets the technical specification and evaluation criteria given above would only be considered (As per conditions mentioned in Evaluation Criteria).



- 26. **System of Award of Contract:** The bidder who satisfies the qualification criteria and offers lowest (L1) would be selected.
- 27. **Force Majeure**: Force Majeure is herein defined as any cause, which is beyond control of the selected Bidder or the ICAT as the case may be which they could not foresee, or this a reasonable amount of diligence could not have foreseen, and which substantially affect the performance of the Contract, such as:




