ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The bidder shall be a legally valid entity either in the form of Proprietary firm, Partnership firm, or Private Limited Company which are registered in India.

In support of above, the bidder is required to submit the following documents with the technical bid:

- **Proprietary Firm:** A copy of the registration certificate or any relevant document that proves the establishment and legal validity of the proprietary firm.
- **Partnership Firm:** A copy of the Partnership Deed along with the registration certificate issued by the Registrar of Firms, if applicable.
- **Private Limited Company:** A copy of the Certificate of Incorporation issued by the Registrar of Companies (RoC) along with the Memorandum of Association (MOA) and Articles of Association (AOA).
- **Agency:** A copy of the registration certificate or any official document proving the legal validity and registration of the agency under the applicable law (e.g., registration under the Shops and Establishments Act, or other relevant legislation).

These documents should be enclosed along with the technical bid to demonstrate the legal status of the bidder as a valid entity.

The bidder shall explicitly commit, in the form indicated in brackets, to:

- taking the responsibility over the final performances of the equipment installed, and the compliancy with the requirements of the tender
- offering the same conditions of Warranty and Service Support for all the equipment supplied under its Offer, as per the requirements appearing in this tender.
- remaining as the main contact point for ICAT for all design, implementation and service support actions.

In case the bidder authorizes its representative to interact with ICAT, an authorization letter will be submitted by the bidder nominating its representative.

A bidder cannot submit more than one bid.

The bidder should fulfill the following eligibility criteria:

1. **Bidder's Experience:** Bidder should have a minimum 5 years of experience in the relevant business pertaining to the equipment range mentioned in the Annexure III.

- 19.4 The above Bank Guarantee to be issued/endorsed by any branch of Delhi/NCR and should be consisting of Full Address of the bank along with contact details i.e. name, contact no., fax no. & e-mail id of the responsible person issuing the BG.
- 19.5 Performance Bank Guarantee shall be refunded within 30 days of the successful completion of Warranty Period of equipment.
- 19.6 No interest will be paid by ICAT on the amount of Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG).
- 20. ICAT reserves the right to accept or reject any tender, and to annual the tendering process and reject all tenders at any time, prior to award of work without assigning any reasons for such
