Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference for services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price. The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

- 1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
- 2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.

- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
- 15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.

- 17. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers / Service Providers are mandated to ensure compliance with all the applicable laws / acts / rules including but not limited to all Labour Laws such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972 etc. Any non-compliance will be treated as breach of contract and Buyer may take suitable actions as per GeM Contract.

The Director, International Centre for Automotive Technology (ICAT), a division of the National Automotive Board (NAB) under the Ministry of Heavy Industries, Government of India, hereby invites bids through a restrictive bidding process under Proprietary Article Certificate (PAC) on the Government e-Marketplace (GeM) Portal for "Reconditioning of AVL Make Chassis Dyno Drive Installed in VTC-1 at ICAT Centre – 1, Manesar (Haryana)".

Equipment Details for Reconditioning: The scope of work under this tender involves the comprehensive reconditioning of the Inverter and Power Drive Units installed in the VTC-1 Chassis Dynamometer System at ICAT Centre–1, Manesar, Haryana. The bidder shall undertake all necessary activities to restore the equipment to its original operational condition, as per OEM standards.

The technical details of the equipment are provided below for the bidder's reference:

- ➤ Make: AVL
- > **Drive Model:** ACS800-104-0400-5+V991
- > Input Frequency Range: 48 Hz to 63 Hz
- > Input Voltage: 380 V to 500 V (Three Phase)
- > Continuous Maximum Current: 455 A
- > Rated Output Power (No Overload): 315 kW



The reconditioning process shall ensure that all functional, safety, control, and calibration parameters of the equipment are restored to OEM-specified performance levels, and the system is fully operational upon completion.

Other Technical Conditions:

- 1. **Scope of Work:** The scope involves the complete reconditioning of Inverter and Power Drive Units installed in the AVL Make Chassis Dynamometer System, including diagnostics, repair, replacement of faulty parts, calibration, and testing. The bidder shall ensure compatibility and functionality of the system post-repair.
- 2. Site Visit: All interested bidders are required to conduct site visit to the ICAT Centre-1, Manesar, Haryana, to physically inspect the AVL Make Chassis Dyno System, including the installed Inverter and Power Drives, prior to submission of the bid. The purpose of the site visit is to allow bidders to assess the existing installation, understand technical and logistical requirements, evaluate the nature and extent of the reconditioning work, and clarify any technical or operational constraints. Bidders must schedule the visit in advance by contacting the designated ICAT official via email or phone, as specified in the tender notice. Site visits will be permitted only on working days during office hours and must be completed no later than 5 (five) working days prior to the last date of bid submission. All expenses related to the site visit shall be borne by the bidder. ICAT will not be responsible for any logistical or travel arrangements of the bidders.

3. Technical Requirements

- ➤ Only genuine or OEM-recommended spare parts/components shall be used.
- > Diagnostic and testing reports must be provided before and after the reconditioning.
- > All reconditioned units must be calibrated and validated to function at par with OEM specifications.
- ➤ The system should be fully integrated and tested post-installation at the ICAT premises.

4. Delivery and Completion Period

- ➤ The timeline for the completion of reconditioning, including shipping, reinstallation, and testing, shall not exceed 180 days from the date of issuance of the Purchase Order.
- Any delay beyond the stipulated period will attract liquidated damages at the rate of 0.5% per week, subject to a maximum of 10% of the contract value.
- 5. **Liquidated Damages (LD):** The entire reconditioning activity, including removal, repair, reinstallation, and testing of the Inverter and Power Drives of the **AVL Make Chassis Dyno System**, shall be completed strictly within the time period stipulated in the Purchase Order. In the event of delay in completion of the work beyond the specified schedule, the successful bidder shall be liable to pay Liquidated Damages (LD), not as a penalty but as a genuine preestimate of loss, at the rate of **0.5% (half percent)** of the total contract value per week of delay or part thereof. The total cumulative LD shall not exceed **10% (ten percent)** of the total contract value. Once the maximum limit is reached, ICAT reserves the right to initiate termination proceedings, risk purchase, or any other action deemed appropriate under the contract. The imposition of LD shall be without prejudice to other remedies available to ICAT under the terms of the contract.

6. Import Compliance

- ➤ The bidder shall be responsible for export and import documentation, packaging, customs clearance, and transportation of units both ways (to and from India).
- Any applicable duties and taxes in the country of origin shall be borne by the supplier.



7. Warranty & Post-Reconditioning Support

- ➤ Minimum 12-month warranty shall be provided for all reconditioned parts/components from the date of acceptance.
- ➤ The bidder shall ensure availability of technical support and spares during the warranty period.
- Any failure during the warranty period must be attended to within 2 working days of notification.

8. Payment Terms

- ▶ 80% payment shall be released upon successful delivery and re-installation of the reconditioned units at the site.
- ➤ 20% shall be released after successful performance testing and acceptance by ICAT.
- **9. Performance Guarantee:** The successful bidder shall furnish Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) equivalent to 5% of the contract value, valid for the entire warranty period.
- 10. **Risk Purchase:** In case the selected bidder fails to deliver within the stipulated time or as per the specifications, ICAT reserves the right to procure the same services from an alternative source at the cost and risk of the defaulting bidder.
- 11. The bidder must clearly indicate whether the service involves complete off-site shipment or on-site repair.
- 12. All shipping-related coordination shall be conducted in consultation with the ICAT logistics team.
- 13. The supplier shall ensure full data confidentiality and not use any proprietary information or system data for any unauthorized purpose.
- 14. **Sub-Contracting Prohibited:** The bidder shall execute the entire scope of work under this tender directly, without engaging any third party or subcontractor. All activities—including removal, repair, reinstallation, calibration, and testing of the Inverter and Power Drives—must be carried out using the bidder's own resources and personnel. The bidder shall remain solely responsible for full performance and compliance with all contractual obligations. Any attempt at sub-contracting shall be treated as a material breach, entitling ICAT to take appropriate legal and contractual action, including termination and forfeiture of security.
- 15. Liability for Damage, Loss, or Incident: The bidder shall exercise the highest degree of care and diligence in handling, transporting, repairing, and reinstalling the Inverter and Power Drives of the AVL Make Chassis Dyno System. The bidder shall be fully liable for any damage, loss, theft, or incident affecting the equipment during the entire period of reconditioning, including removal, shipment (if applicable), storage, repair, and reinstallation. In the event of any such occurrence, the bidder shall, at its own cost and without any delay, repair or replace the affected equipment to the satisfaction of ICAT, ensuring that the system is restored to its original operational condition as per OEM specifications. This liability shall be absolute and shall not be limited by any insurance coverage, third-party involvement, or force majeure, except as expressly provided under the contract. ICAT shall have the right to recover the full cost of replacement, repair, or restoration, including any consequential damages or operational losses, from the bidder or from any amounts due or performance security held under the contract.

17. Transportation, Handling, and Delivery

FOR ICAT Project Site: The scope of the bidder shall include the complete responsibility for To & Fro logistics of the equipment/material covered under this tender, on a FOR



(Free on Road/Rail) ICAT Project Site basis, including all incidental costs and arrangements. The following conditions shall apply:

- > Scope of Logistics Responsibility: The bidder shall be solely responsible for the packing, forwarding, loading, transportation, transit insurance, unloading, and safe delivery of the material/equipment to and from the ICAT Centre 1, Manesar, Haryana.
- Packing & Handling: The bidder shall ensure that the equipment is appropriately packed using industry-standard practices to prevent damage during transit. Special care shall be taken for sensitive electronic and power drive components.
- > **Transportation:** All transportation (both outbound and inbound, if equipment is to be sent to an external facility for reconditioning) shall be arranged by the bidder at their own cost and risk. No separate payment shall be made for any transportation, labour, handling, or related activity.

Annexure - B Eligibility & Evaluation Criteria

Annexure - C

General Terms & Conditions

- Scope of Work: The scope involves the complete reconditioning of Inverter and Power Drive Units installed in the AVL Make Chassis Dynamometer System, including diagnostics, repair, replacement of faulty parts, calibration, and testing. The bidder shall ensure compatibility and functionality of the system post-repair.
- 2. **Site Visit:** All interested bidders are required to conduct site visit to the ICAT Centre-1, Manesar, Haryana, to physically inspect the AVL Make Chassis Dyno System, including the installed Inverter and Power Drives, prior to submission of the bid. The purpose of the site visit is to allow bidders to assess the existing installation, understand technical and logistical requirements, evaluate the nature and extent of the reconditioning work, and clarify any technical or operational constraints. Bidders must schedule the visit in advance by contacting the designated ICAT official via email or phone, as specified in the tender notice. Site visits will be permitted only on working days during office hours and must be completed no later than 5 (five) working days prior to the last date of bid submission. All expenses related to the site visit shall be borne by the bidder. ICAT will not be responsible for any logistical or travel arrangements of the bidders.

3. Technical Requirements

- > Only genuine or OEM-recommended spare parts/components shall be used.

The Owner shall have the right to make an unlimited number of Demands under this bank guarantee provided that the aggregate of all sums paid to the Owner by the Bank under this bank guarantee shall not exceed the Guaranteed Amount.
