Special Note:

- **Site Visit:** Bidders are strongly advised to visit the site and familiarize themselves with the existing conditions before submitting their proposals. Submission of the bid will be deemed to imply that the bidder has undertaken such a visit and is fully aware of the site requirements.
- **Transportation and Handling:** The scope of the successful bidder shall include all activities related to packing, loading, shifting, transportation, unloading, and safe storage of the material at the site. All materials must be adequately protected to prevent damage during transit and handling. The bidder shall be solely responsible for any damages incurred during delivery, and such damaged items must be replaced at no additional cost to the client.

- **Material Quality and Approval:** All materials used for the project shall be brand new, free from any defects or faults. Prior approval must be obtained from the ICAT representative before the use or delivery of any materials.
- **Documentation and Certification:** The bidder shall provide all necessary documentation including technical data sheets, and valid test certificates of the materials, either prior to or at the time of delivery, as required by the Engineer-in-Charge.
- **Work Execution:** All site work must be carried out in accordance with the directions of the Engineer-in-Charge and in compliance with the site requirements.

Other Technical Conditions:

1. **Clarifications, Deviations, and Conditional Bids:** Bidders are strictly advised to submit their bids in full compliance with all terms, conditions, technical specifications, and requirements stipulated in this tender document. Conditional bids or bids containing deviations, exceptions, assumptions, or qualifications shall be summarily rejected without further reference or clarification, at the sole discretion of the Purchaser.

Any suggestions, clarifications, or concerns regarding the tender terms and conditions must be formally raised by the Bidders only during the Pre-Bid Meeting. The Purchaser shall review such requests and reserves the absolute right to accept, modify, or reject any suggestion or concern, wholly or in part, without assigning any reason, and solely in the best interest of the Purchaser.

All clarifications, amendments, or modifications arising out of the Pre-Bid Meeting shall be published either as a Corrigendum and/or as the Minutes of the Pre-Bid Meeting (MoM) on the Purchaser's official website (www.icat.in) and on the CPP Portal. These shall form an integral part of the tender and shall be binding on all Bidders. No request for changes or deviations shall be entertained after the Pre-Bid stage.

2. **Proposal Submission Compliance and Documentation Requirements:** The Bidder is required to submit their proposal in strict compliance with all terms, conditions, and technical requirements outlined in this tender document. The technical bid must include comprehensive details of the proposed solution, including the products, services, specifications, and relevant technical literature, clearly demonstrating conformance to the specified requirements. A Statement of Compliance, in the format prescribed within the Technical Specifications, shall be submitted for each item listed. Each compliance statement must be substantiated with authentic, verifiable documentation (e.g., brochures, datasheets, certifications) issued by the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) or other credible sources. Furthermore, each page of the bid, including any amendments, corrections, or insertions, must be duly signed and stamped by the authorized signatory of the Bidder, thereby certifying its accuracy and authenticity. Failure to adhere to any of the above requirements may render the bid liable for rejection at the sole discretion of the Purchaser.
3. **Assignment and Subcontracting:** The Contractor shall not, without the prior written consent of the Procuring Entity, sublet, transfer, assign, or otherwise dispose of the contract or any part thereof, or any interest, benefit, or advantage arising therefrom, in any manner whatsoever. The Contractor shall provide written notification to the Procuring Entity of all subcontracts awarded under this contract, if such subcontracts were not already disclosed in the original bid or contract. Such notification shall not absolve the Contractor of any liability or obligation under the contract. Subcontracting shall be permitted solely for the procurement of bought-out items and incidental works or services. All

subcontracts must fully comply with the Contractor's obligations under this contract and shall not be used to circumvent the Contractor's responsibilities or obligations that formed the basis for the award of this contract. Any assignment, subletting, or transfer of this contract, or any part thereof, made without the prior written consent of the Procuring Entity shall constitute a material breach of contract. In such an event, the Procuring Entity shall have the right to invoke any or all remedies available under the contract or applicable law.

4. **Brand and Product Availability:** The brand quoted must not be "end-of-life" or "end-of-sale" products at the time of bid submission. Should the quoted brand become unavailable at the time of delivery, the bidder shall replace or substitute the quoted brand with a superior alternative at no additional cost to the ICAT.
5. **Adherence to Tender Specifications:** Bidders must provide products exactly as specified in the tender.
6. **Evaluation Criteria and Compliance:** The product specifications and brands mentioned in the tender are the sole criteria for evaluation. Bidders must ensure the signed and stamped complete tender documents and submit along with the bid.
7. **Defect Liability Period (DLP):** The successful bidder hereby warrants that the completed works shall be free from defects arising from faulty materials or workmanship for a period of **24 Months** commencing from the date of certified completion of the work.
 - During this defect's liability period (DLP), the contractor shall be responsible for addressing any issues related to material defect or improper installation /structure cracks/peeled out/painting that may be attributed to poor workmanship or failure to perform the work in accordance with the tender specifications. The obligations of the Successful Contractor under this clause shall survive the completion and final acceptance of the works and shall remain in full force throughout the entire Defects Liability Period.
 - Key obligations during the Defect's Liability Period (DLP) includes: → Attending to and rectifying any issues arising from defect material or improper workmanship or non-compliance with the scope of work. → Responding to ICAT's written complaints within 48 Hours and resolving the issue at no additional cost.
 - Carrying out remedial actions in a professional and time-bound manner to ensure smooth use of structure.
 - During this Defects Liability Period, the Successful Bidder shall, at their own cost, and to the satisfaction of the Employer, promptly rectify, or replace any defects, deficiencies, or faults that may arise in the works, upon written notice from the Employer.
 - If the Successful Bidder fails to remedy such defects within a reasonable period following written notice, the Employer shall have the right to engage third parties to carry out the work and all costs, losses, damages, and expenses incurred by the Employer in connection therewith shall be fully recoverable from the bidder.
 - Such recovery may be affected through: Failure to fulfill Defect Liability Period (DLP) obligations may lead to forfeiture of the Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) or deductions from any outstanding payments and where such amounts are insufficient, the Employer shall be entitled to recover the outstanding balance from the Contractor by any lawful means.
8. **Work Completion Period:** The bidder shall complete "Civil works for upgradation of lift capacity test facility of CEV machines and agriculture tractor" as specified in the tender within 45 days from the issuance of the Notice to Proceed (NTP) by the Site In-Charge.

- The completion period encompasses all activities related to the supply of material, site preparation, installation, and any other necessary steps to ensure the work meet the specified quality and durability standards.
- Any delay beyond the agreed completion period, without prior written approval from the client, will result in penalties as outlined in the bid document. The bidder must notify the client in advance of any potential delays, providing justifiable reasons and a revised completion schedule if necessary.
- The project will be considered complete once the entire work has been fully completed, inspected, and accepted by the client, following the completion of all required final inspections.

9. Scope of Work and Responsibilities:

- **Supply and Installation:** The successful bidder shall be fully responsible for the “Civil works for upgradation of lift capacity test facility of CEV machines and agriculture tractor” that the work is executed in a professional manner and in compliance with the technical specifications outlined in the tender document. The bidder must ensure the highest quality of materials and finishing, adhering to all required standards and timelines.

10. Liquidated Damages (LD) Clause

- The bidder must complete the entire works of “Civil works for upgradation of lift capacity test facility of CEV machines and agriculture tractor” within the agreed 45-days period from the issuance of NTP, or as otherwise mutually agreed in writing.
- In the event of a delay, liquidated damages will be imposed at a rate of **0.5%** of the total contract value for each week of delay, up to a maximum of **10%** of the total contract value. Liquidated damages will be deducted from the final payment to the bidder.
- The imposition of liquidated damages does not preclude ICAT from pursuing any other remedies or seeking compensation for damages caused by delays, nor does it affect ICAT's right to terminate the contract for cause if necessary.
- If the delay is caused by factors beyond the control of the bidder (e.g., natural disasters, strikes), the bidder must notify the client in writing within **7 days**, and an extension of time may be granted without penalty, subject to the client's approval.

11. Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) Clause

- The successful bidder needs to submit a Performance Bank Guarantee within 15 days from the date of signing of LoA/PO with ICAT. PBG should be issued from any branch of Delhi/NCR of any Indian scheduled Bank, for an amount equivalent to the **3%** of the contract value to cover for contract period i.e. 2 Years. The PBG shall be made in INR only.
- The PBG must be issued by a reputable bank and be valid for 24 months (which includes warranty period, delivery period & such other duration as stipulated in the contract). The PBG value shall be **3%** of the total contract value and must be submitted in the prescribed format.
- In the event the selected bidder fails to submit the Performance Bank Guarantee within the stipulated time frame, ICAT reserves the right to cancel the order placed with the selected bidder, without notice.
- ICAT shall have the right to invoke the Performance Bank Guarantee if the selected bidder fails to fulfil its contractual obligations during the contract period or if ICAT incurs any loss due to the bidder's negligence in carrying out the project implementation in accordance with the agreed terms and conditions.
- No interest will be paid by ICAT on the amount of Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG)
- In the event the selected bidder fails to submit the Performance Bank Guarantee within the stipulated time frame, ICAT reserves the right to cancel the order placed with the selected bidder, without notice, and to forfeit the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD).

12. Quantity Variation: The quantities for work listed in the Bill of Quantities (BOQ) represent the estimated requirement and may be increase or decrease up to 20 %, based on actual site conditions. No price adjustment shall be entertained due to any deviation in quantities after bid submission.

13. Payment Terms:

- Payment will be made against Running Amount (R.A.) Bills or final bill as per the purchase/work order, upon submission of the invoice, a valid E-way bill, and any other required documents.
- All statutory deductions, including but not limited to GST and TDS, will be deducted at source.
- No price escalation will be permitted, even if the project period is extended.
- Transportation, loading, and unloading charges will be borne by the bidder.
- The quoted price should be for delivery at ICAT Manesar Centre-2, inclusive of GST, packing, forwarding, loading, unloading, and all other associated charges.

14. Offer Validity: Bids should remain valid for at least 180 days from the date of opening the Technical Bid. Bids with a shorter validity period will be rejected. ICAT reserves the right to request an extension of the validity period, if required.

15. Pricing and Discrepancies: Prices must be quoted in INR and in figures only. In case of a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price calculated by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price will prevail, and the total price will be corrected.

16. Product Specifications & Compliance: The bidder must quote products strictly according to the technical specifications outlined in the tender. A detailed technical compliance statement, including brand names, specifications, and supporting documents, must be submitted with the technical bid. **Each page of the bid must be signed and stamped by the authorized signatory.** Failure to comply with this may result in bid rejection.

17. Product Availability and Support Condition: The product offered must not be classified as "end-of-life" or "end-of-sale" as of the bid submission date. In the event that support for the quoted product is discontinued or withdrawn prior to delivery, the bidder shall, at no additional cost to the purchaser, replace the quoted product with a superior alternative that meets or exceeds the original specifications. The replacement product must be of Substantially Equivalent or higher quality and functionality, ensuring no disruption to the purchaser's requirements.

18. Insurance of Materials: The bidder shall ensure that all materials are packaged and insured against damage until delivery to ICAT, Manesar. The bidder is fully responsible for safe delivery. Any damaged or defective material during transit must be replaced by the bidder at no additional cost to ICAT.

19. Warranty/Guarantee Conditions: The bidder must provide a comprehensive warranty for the "Civil works for upgradation of lift capacity test facility of CEV machines and agriculture tractor" covering

both materials and workmanship. The warranty period shall commence from the date of successful completion and handover and remain valid for a minimum of **24 Months**.

- During the warranty period, the bidder shall be responsible for the repair or replacement of any defects or failures arising from faulty materials, improper installation, structure cracks, improper painting, or failure to meet specified standards. This includes, but is not limited to, issues such as discoloration, or other failures.
- The bidder must ensure that all material meet the specified technical requirements outlined in the tender in **Chapter - 2**. Any defects or poor performance discovered during the warranty period must be rectified at no additional cost, including both labour and materials.
- A warranty certificate detailing the scope, terms, and conditions of the warranty, including the entire project must be provided. The bidder must respond to any defects within 15 days of notification and carry out the necessary repairs or replacement at no additional cost.
- Failure to meet warranty obligations will result in penalties and may lead to contract termination or legal action in accordance with the agreement's terms.

20. Unsatisfactory Performance: ICAT reserves the right to assess the performance of the bidder's work and may reject any system or component that does not meet the required standards. If the performance is unsatisfactory, ICAT may reject the system, either partially or fully, and the bidder will be bound by ICAT's decision.

21. Contract Termination: If the vendor's performance is unsatisfactory regarding timely delivery or product quality, ICAT will issue a warning letter. If the issues persist after a second warning, ICAT reserves the right to terminate the contract with 30 days' written notice without further explanation. Any amounts due to the vendor will be paid or forfeited as per the contract terms, and the vendor must withdraw their materials from ICAT premises within a month.

22. Confidential Information: Both ICAT and the selected bidder shall maintain the confidentiality of all documents, data, and information related to the contract. This information shall not be disclosed to any third party without prior written consent.

23. Dispute Resolution: Any dispute arising out of this tender shall be referred to arbitration, with the decision of the arbitrator appointed by the Director of ICAT being binding. If disputes persist, the matter will be referred to the High Court of Haryana or another appropriate court in Gurugram (Haryana).

24. Amendment or Withdrawal of Tender: ICAT reserves the right to amend or withdraw the tender at any stage without any obligation to notify the bidders. ICAT also reserves the right to disqualify any bidder at any stage, and to reject any or all bids without assigning reasons.

25. Please ensure that Tender documents must be signed and stamped on all pages as a token of acceptance of all the terms and conditions.

26. Law of the Republic of India are applicable to this tender.

27. Qualification Criteria: The bidder whose bid meets the technical specification and evaluation criteria given above would only be considered (As per conditions mentioned in Evaluation Criteria).

28. System of Award of Contract: The bidder who satisfies the qualification criteria and offers lowest (L1) would be selected.

29. Fraud and Corruption: The bidders, suppliers and contractors shall observe the highest standard of ethics during bidding and during performance of the contract. For the purposes of this provision, the following acts shall be considered as corrupt and/or fraudulent practices.

- “Corrupt Practice” means offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting directly or indirectly, of anything of value to influence the action of an official in the procurement process or in contract execution.
- “Fraudulent Practice” means misrepresentation or omission of facts in order to execution of contract.
- “Collusive Practice” means a scheme or arrangement between two or more bidders, with or without the knowledge of the purchaser, designed to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive level.
- “Coercive Practice” means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in a procurement process or in execution of a contract.
- During the process of evaluation of a bid or proposal for award of a contract, if it is detected that a bidder directly or through agent has engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive or coercive practice in competing for the contract in question, then a) the bid shall be rejected and b) declare the firm ineligible for a specific period or indefinitely to participate in a bidding process.
- Bidders may note that CPP portal is capturing and showing the IP addresses used by the Buyer and Bidder(s)/Seller(s). Bids submitted from IP addresses that are identical to or shared with other Bidders/Sellers shall be deemed invalid and automatically disqualified from further evaluation.

30. Collusive Bidding or Bid Rigging or Cartelization: The Bidder(s) acknowledges and agrees that any form of bid rigging, cartelization, or coordination among bidders, aimed at manipulating the bidding process or prices, is strictly prohibited. In the event of any evidence or suspicion of collusion, bid rigging, or cartel behaviour, the Tendering Authority reserves the right to reject the bid(s) and take appropriate legal action, including but not limited to debarment from future tenders and reporting to relevant authorities. Bidders are required to submit their bids independently, without any undue influence or agreement with other participants in the tender process.

31. Preference to Local Suppliers, Micro & Small Enterprises (MSE’s), and Startups:

- Preference as per Government Policy: ICAT reserves the right to extend preference to Local Suppliers, Micro and Small Enterprises (MSE’s), and Startups, in accordance with the applicable guidelines, circulars, and notifications issued by the Government of India, as amended from time to time. Such preference shall be accorded only upon submission of valid, relevant, and verifiable supporting documents along with the bid. Failure to provide the required documentation shall result in ineligibility for any preferential treatment.

32. Relaxation of Prior Turnover and Experience Requirements: ICAT, at its sole discretion, may relax the requirements of prior turnover and prior experience for start-up enterprises recognized by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), provided that such entities fully comply with all quality standards, technical specifications, and performance criteria as specified in the tender documents. Such start-ups may be MSMEs or otherwise. Only registered Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) and DPIIT-recognized start-ups shall be considered for relaxation under this provision. Any such relaxation shall be strictly conditional upon the enterprise’s demonstrated capability to meet all functional, operational, and contractual requirements of the tender. This relaxation shall be applied in accordance with the provisions of applicable government policies and shall not compromise adherence to the tender's prescribed technical, quality, or performance requirements. Chapter - 3

Minimum Eligibility Criteria

Eligibility Criteria (Pre-Qualification Requirements): Only those Bidders who meet the following pre-qualification criteria shall be considered eligible to participate in this procurement process. Bidders must provide satisfactory documentary evidence in support of each requirement listed herein. **Any bid that fails to comply with or demonstrate conformance to the stipulated eligibility conditions shall be treated as non-responsive, and such bid shall be summarily rejected without further evaluation, including exclusion from the technical assessment stage.**

The Purchaser reserves the right to verify the authenticity of the documents submitted and to request additional clarifications, if deemed necessary. Submission of false, misleading, or unverifiable information shall lead to immediate disqualification and may also invite further action as per applicable laws and tender conditions.

Pre-qualification/Minimum Eligibility Criteria for the Bidders:

1. **Legal Valid Entity:** The bidder shall necessarily be a legal valid entity in the form of a proprietary firm, partnership firm, private limited company (enclose a copy of the registration or incorporation certificate with the technical bid).

Chapter 6

Instructions To Bidders

1. **Submission of Quotation and Technical Documentation:** The bidder shall submit a comprehensive quotation strictly in accordance with the detailed Scope of Work and Services outlined in “Chapter - 2” of the Additional Terms and Conditions (NIT/ATC) document.
