The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$, subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

Chapter - 2

Minimum Eligibility Criteria & Technical Evaluation

Eligibility Criteria (Pre-Qualification Requirements): Only those Bidders who meet the following Pre-Qualification Criteria shall be considered eligible to participate in this procurement process. Bidders must provide satisfactory documentary evidence in support of each requirement listed herein. Any bid that fails to comply with or demonstrate conformance to the stipulated eligibility conditions shall be treated as non-responsive, and such bid shall be summarily rejected without further evaluation, including exclusion from the technical assessment stage.

The Purchaser reserves the right to verify the authenticity of the documents submitted and to request additional clarifications, if deemed necessary. Submission of false, misleading, or unverifiable information shall lead to immediate disqualification and may also invite further action as per applicable laws and tender conditions.

Minimum Eligibility Criteria (MEC) & Technical Evaluation of Bids:

The Technical Evaluation of bids shall be done as per following MEC. Any bid failing to meet the eligibility criteria below shall be rejected and will not be considered for Financial Evaluation:

1. The bidder shall necessarily be a legal valid entity in the form of Proprietary Firm, Partnership Firm, Private Limited Company (*enclose a copy of registration/incorporation certificate with technical bid*).
2. **Bidder must have PAN & GST** (*enclose a copy of PAN & GST with technical bid*).
3. **Technical Compliance:** The bidder should meet the Technical Specifications mentioned in the Chapter 1. The bidder submits the duly signed & stamped (*each page*) tender documents. **Failure to submit complete, valid, and verifiable documents** in accordance with the above requirements may lead to **disqualification of the bid** without further evaluation.

6. The bidder must have experience with Govt. of India [*a proof of total business (with Govt. of India) of ₹ 25 Lakh or above during last 3 years, to be submitted in the form of distinct POs & Tax Invoices with Technical bid*].

1. **Proposal Submission Compliance and Documentation Requirements:** The Bidder is required to submit their proposal in strict compliance with all terms, conditions, and requirements outlined in this tender document. The technical bid must include comprehensive details of the proposed solution, including the products, services, specifications, and relevant technical literature clearly demonstrating conformance to the specified requirements. 1. **Definitions:** For the purpose of this Tender/ATC document the term "**ICAT**" shall mean International Centre for Automotive Technology and shall include its authorized representatives, officers and officials. The term "**Agency**", "**Bidder**" or "**Service Provider**" shall mean the successful bidder to whom the contract is awarded. The term "**Work**" shall include design, development, manufacturing, assembling, supply, installation & commissioning of 3D Layout Scale Model required by ICAT and as specified in Chapter 1 of this Tender/ATC document. The term "**Competent Authority**" shall mean the authorized officer designated by ICAT for administration and supervision of the contract.
2. **Scope of Work/Service:** The scope of work under this tender/ATC shall include **Supply, Installation & Commissioning of 3D Layout Scale Model for ICAT-Centre-I and ICAT Centre-II** (*As per detailed scope of work defined in "Chapter - 1"*).
3. **Award of Work Order/PO:** The Lowest Financial Bid(s) (L1) for Scope of Work (SOW) as per Part-A and Part-B of the Technically Qualified Bidders shall be deemed as the 'Successful Bidder(s)'. Accordingly, the Work Order/PO will be awarded to the bidder whoever will be the L1 in combined price of SOW- Part (A & B).
4. **Delivery Period:** Within 75 days from the date of GeM Contract
5. **Warranty:** 01 Year from the date of final acceptance.
6. **Work Orders and Deliverables:** All assignments under this tender/ATC document shall be executed only against written PO/Work Order or approved communications issued by ICAT. The supplier shall complete the work strictly within the timelines specified in the respective PO/WO and deliver the items as per required specifications/scope of work.
7. **Liquidated Damages (LD) Clause:** The Agency shall adhere strictly to the delivery timelines, quality standards, statutory requirements and other obligations stipulated in the Work Order/Contract. In the event of seller's failure to deliver the goods/equipment as per date/dates specified in the contract, ICAT may deduct from the seller as agreed, Liquidated Damages @ 0.5% of the Contract Sum of the delayed supplies for each week or part of a week for which the delay has occurred, subject to maximum of 10% of the Contract Sum.
8. **Quality Standards:** The agency shall maintain high professional and technical standards while executing the assignments and shall deploy qualified manpower and industry-standard equipment for production of audio-visual content. All deliverables shall conform to professional broadcast, digital and multimedia quality standards acceptable to ICAT.

In case the quality of work is found unsatisfactory, technically deficient or inconsistent with the approved brief, ICAT reserves the right to reject the deliverables, and the agency shall rectify the same at its own cost within the stipulated time.
9. **Payment Terms:** 100% payments after satisfactory completion of the work, submission of final deliverables and acceptance of 3D Layout Scale Models by ICAT along with submission of valid invoice(s).

OR

For assignments requiring advance payment, ICAT may allow milestone-based payment subject to submission of an Advance Bank Guarantee (ABG) from a Scheduled Commercial Bank equivalent to 110% of the advance amount. In such cases, payment shall be released in the following manner:

All payments shall be released subject to satisfactory completion of the respective milestone and approval by ICAT. Mere submission of invoice shall not entitle the Service Provider to claim payment unless the related deliverables are accepted by ICAT.

Applicable taxes, TDS, Liquidated Damages (LD) or any other recoveries as per contract terms shall be deducted from the payments. ICAT reserves the right to withhold or recover payment in case of delay, poor quality of work, non-performance or breach of contractual conditions. No interest shall be payable by ICAT on delayed payments due to administrative or procedural reasons.

- 10. Indemnity:** The agency shall indemnify and keep indemnified ICAT against all claims, losses, liquidity damages, liabilities, litigations, copyright disputes, labor disputes and third-party claims arising out of negligence, misconduct, statutory non-compliance or breach of contractual obligations by the agency, its personnel, representatives or subcontractors engaged for execution of the work.
- 11. Force Majeure:** Neither party shall be held responsible for any delay or failure in performance of obligations under the contract due to events beyond reasonable control including natural calamities, war, riots, strikes, pandemics, government restrictions or other force majeure conditions. The affected party shall promptly notify the other party regarding occurrence and cessation of such circumstances, and both parties shall take reasonable steps to minimize the impact of such events.
- 12. Termination of Contract:** The Contract shall remain valid for the prescribed contract period unless terminated earlier in accordance with the provisions contained herein. International Centre for Automotive Technology (ICAT) reserves the right to terminate the contract, wholly or partially, at any stage during the currency of the contract in the interest of the organization and such termination shall not prejudice or affect any rights, remedies, obligations or liabilities accrued prior to the date of termination.

13. Termination by Mutual Consent: The contract may be terminated at any time by mutual written consent of both parties in the event the services are no longer required or due to administrative, operational or business considerations. In such cases, the Service Provider shall be entitled only to payments against satisfactorily completed services and accepted deliverables up to the effective date of termination. No consequential damages, compensation, loss of future business, termination charges or any other claims whatsoever shall be admissible against ICAT on account of such termination.

13.1 Termination due to Breach of Contractual Obligations: ICAT shall have the right to terminate the contract forthwith or by giving such notice period as deemed appropriate, in the event of any material breach of contractual obligations by the Service Provider. Such breaches shall include, but shall not be limited to, failure to perform the services as per agreed timelines and specifications, persistent poor performance, submission of substandard deliverables, unauthorized subcontracting, breach of confidentiality obligations, violation of statutory provisions, misrepresentation, fraudulent practices, integrity violations or failure to comply with lawful instructions issued by ICAT.

In cases where the breach is capable of being remedied, ICAT may issue a written notice requiring the Service Provider to cure the deficiency within a period of **fourteen (14) days** or such extended period as may be considered appropriate by ICAT. In the event the Service Provider fails to remedy the breach within the stipulated period, ICAT shall be entitled to terminate the contract without any further notice and recover damages, losses or additional costs incurred due to such default from the pending bills, Performance Security or any other dues payable to the Service Provider.

13.2 Termination for Convenience: ICAT reserves the unconditional right to terminate the contract, wholly or partially, at any time during the currency of the contract, for administrative reasons, reduction in requirement, policy changes, operational exigencies or any other reason deemed appropriate by ICAT, by giving prior written notice to the Service Provider. In such cases, the Service Provider shall not be entitled to claim any compensation, damages, loss of profit or future business opportunity arising out of such termination.

13.3 Consequences of Termination Upon termination or expiry of the contract, the Service Provider shall immediately discontinue the services, hand over all completed and in-progress deliverables, documents, raw footage, source files, materials and other property belonging to ICAT and comply with all directions issued by ICAT in this regard. ICAT shall have the right to get the balance work executed through alternate sources at the risk and cost of the Service Provider, without prejudice to any other legal remedies available under the contract or applicable law.

Termination of the contract for any reason whatsoever shall not affect any accrued rights, obligations, claims, remedies or liabilities of either party existing prior to the date of termination. The provisions relating to confidentiality, intellectual property rights, indemnity, dispute resolution and other clauses intended to survive termination shall continue to remain in full force and effect notwithstanding termination or expiry of the contract.

- 14. Integrity Pact and Ethics:** The agency shall observe the highest standards of integrity, transparency and ethical conduct during participation in the tender process and execution of the contract. Any act of canvassing, misrepresentation, cartelization, bribery, corruption or influence of any kind shall render the bidder liable for disqualification, termination of contract, forfeiture of security deposit and blacklisting/debarment in accordance with applicable rules and policies of Government of India.
- 15. Arbitration and Jurisdiction:** Any dispute or difference arising out of or in connection with the contract shall first be resolved amicably through mutual discussions between the parties. In case the dispute remains unresolved, the matter shall be referred to arbitration under the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and amendments thereto. Compliance with Labour Laws:** The agency shall comply with all applicable labour laws and statutory requirements relating to EPF, ESI, Minimum Wages, Contract Labour, occupational safety and welfare measures for personnel deployed under the contract. The personnel engaged by the agency shall remain employees of the agency only and ICAT shall not have any employer-employee relationship or liability whatsoever in respect of such personnel.
- 19. Subcontracting:** The agency shall not subcontract or assign the work, wholly or partially, to any third party without prior written approval of ICAT. In case subcontracting is permitted under exceptional circumstances, the agency shall remain fully responsible and accountable for satisfactory execution of the work and compliance with all contractual obligations.
- 20. Amendment:** ICAT reserves the right to amend, modify, add or delete any provision of the tender or contract in public interest or due to administrative requirements and such amendments shall be binding upon the agency from the date of communication thereof. No verbal understanding or representation shall have any effect unless formally communicated in writing by ICAT.
- 21. Acceptance of Terms:** Submission of bid by the bidder shall be deemed to constitute unconditional acceptance of all terms and conditions of the tender, work orders and Annual Rate Contract. Any deviation, conditional offer or non-compliance with the tender conditions may result in rejection of the bid at the sole discretion of ICAT.

24. **Price:** The prices are to be quoted in INR in figures only. If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected.
25. The tender document is not an offer and is issued with no commitment. ICAT reserves the right to withdraw this notice inviting tender or vary any part thereof at any stage. ICAT further reserves the right to disqualify any bidder, should it be so necessary at any stage. ICAT reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders, wholly or partly, without assigning any reason thereof and shall not be bound to accept the lowest tender.
26. **Qualification Criteria:** The bidder whose bid meets the technical specification and evaluation criteria given above would only be considered (*As per conditions mentioned in as per Chapter 2 of this Tender/ATC document*).
27. **System of Award of Contract:** The bidder who satisfies the qualification criteria and offers lowest (L1) would be selected.
28. Once submitted in e-Procurement, Bidder cannot view or modify his bid since it is locked by encryption. However, resubmission of the bid by the bidders for any number of times superseding earlier bid(s) before the date and time of submission is allowed. Resubmission of a bid shall require uploading of all documents, including financial bid afresh. The system shall consider only the last bid submitted as the valid bid. The bidder may withdraw his bid before the bid submission deadline, and it shall be marked as withdrawn and shall not get opened during the Bid opening. No bid should be withdrawn after the deadline for the bid submission and before the expiry of the bid validity period.

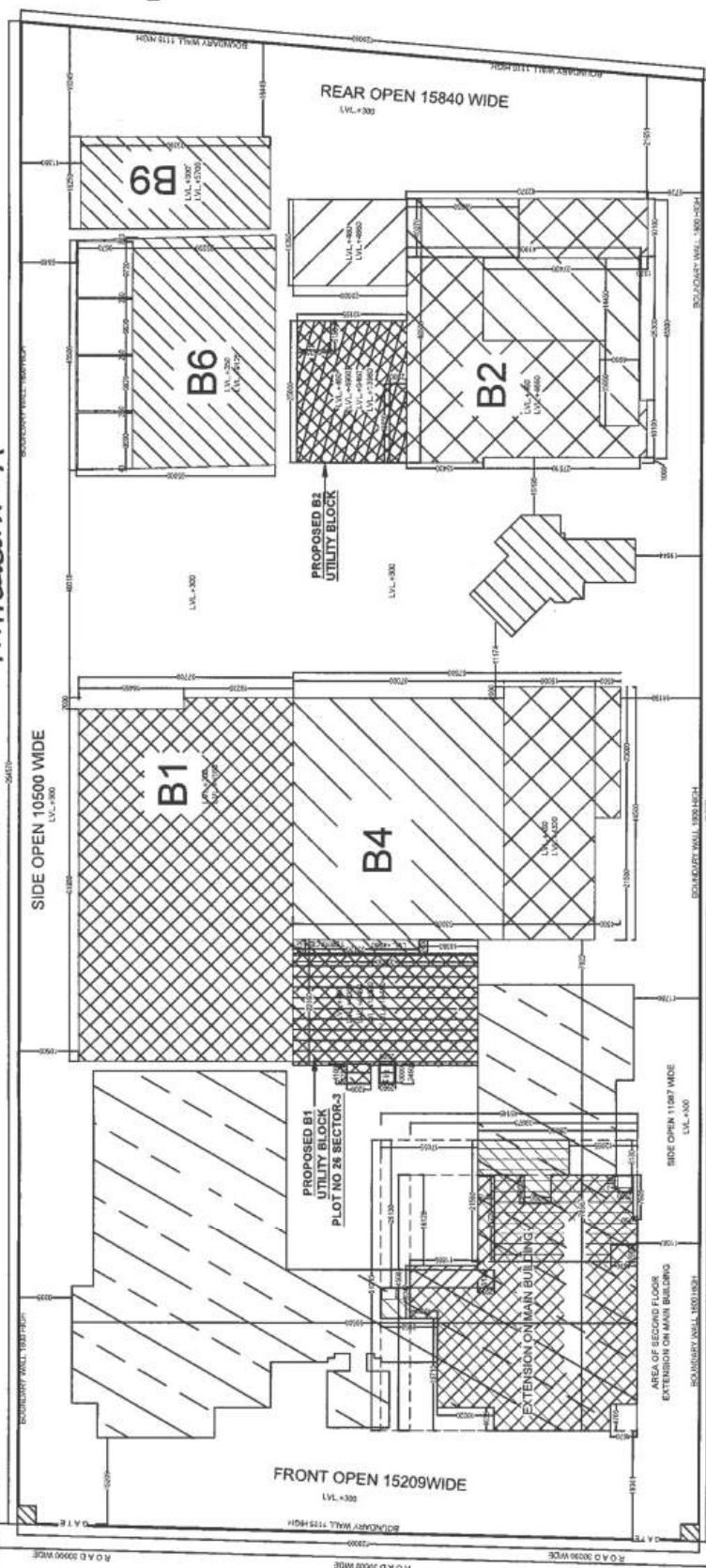

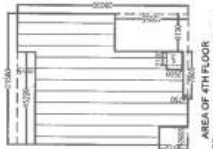

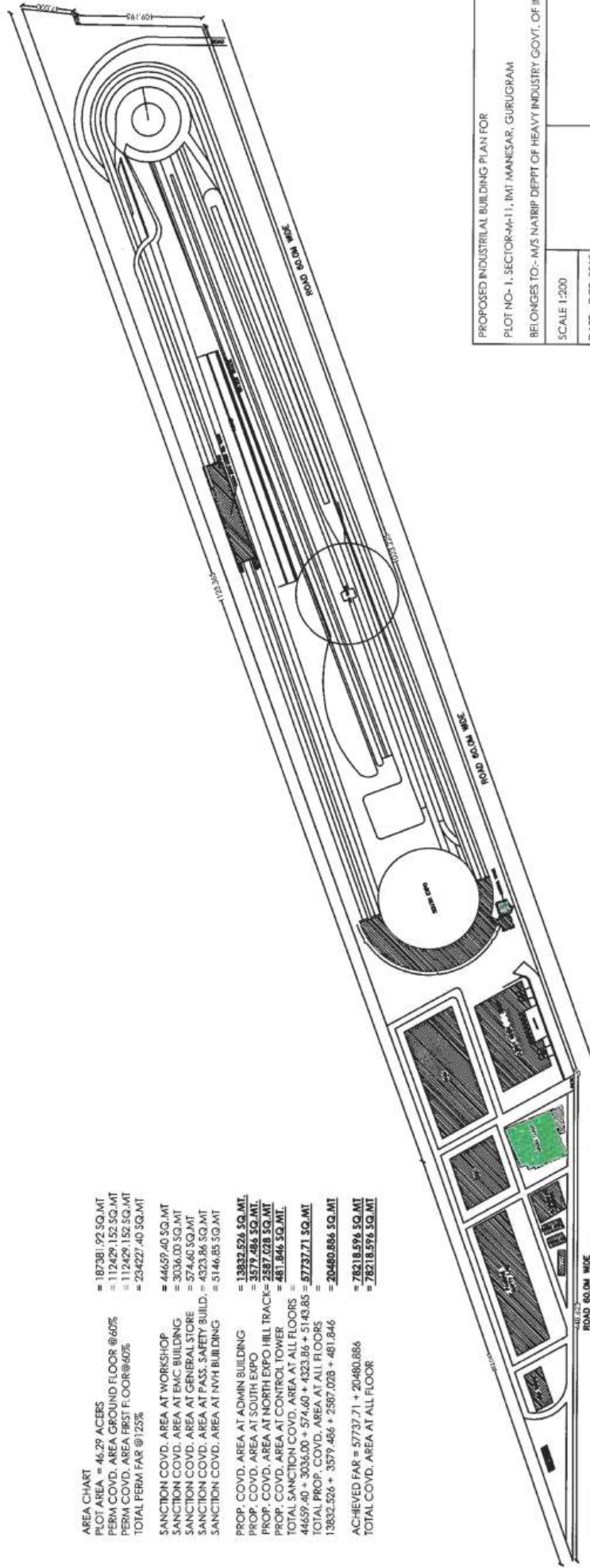
